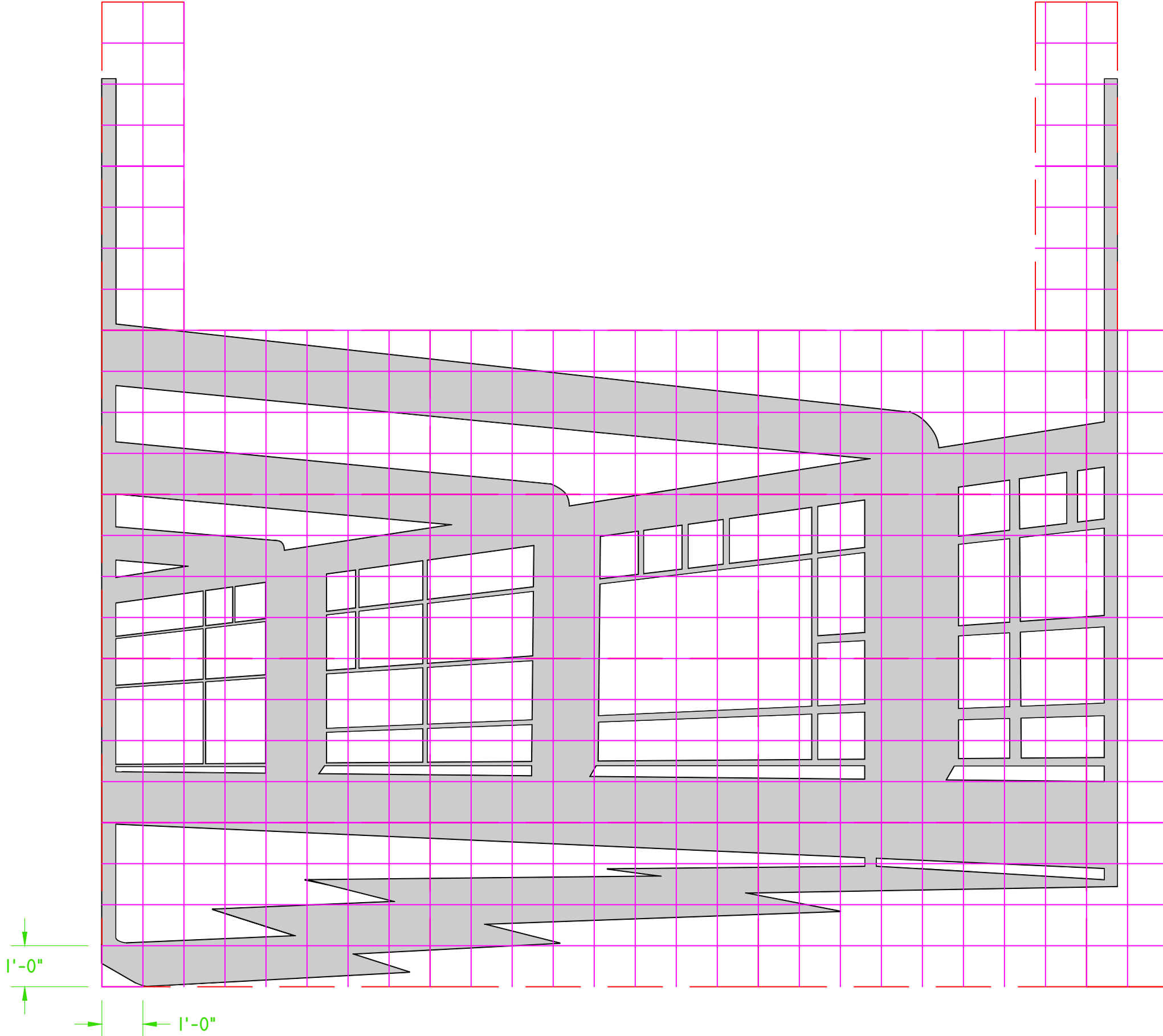

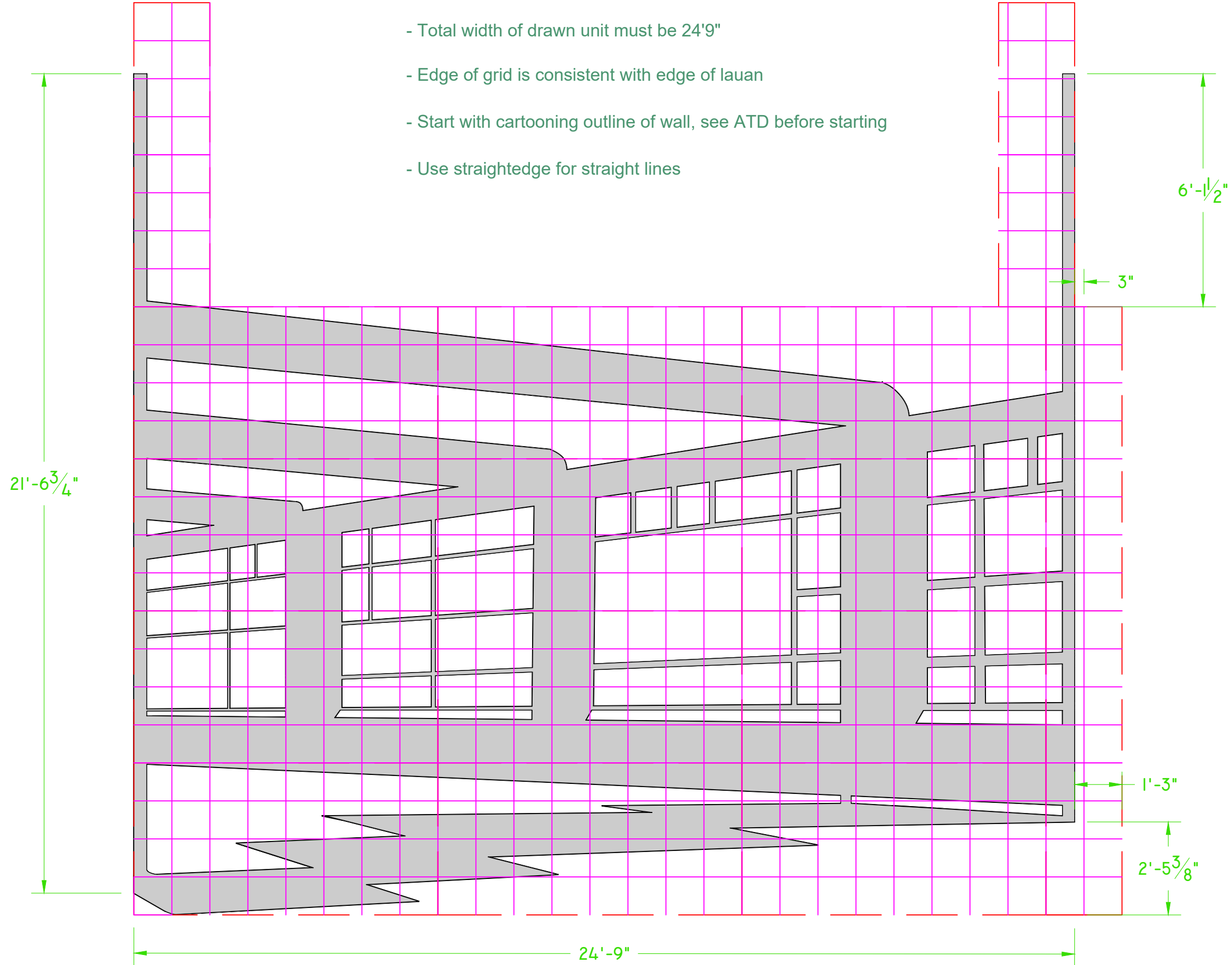

- Start grid from left side, and from bottom





- Total width of drawn unit must be 24'9"
- Edge of grid is consistent with edge of lauan
- Start with cartooning outline of wall, see ATD before starting
- Use straightedge for straight lines

- This plate provides an IDEA of what is necessary for frame structure
- Frame to fit other than pieces for shipping breaks and seams
- See other plates to understand shipping break pieces (3 pieces total)
- Consider tacking together the shipping break pieces, and cutting after
- Frame to fit on top of previously cartooned lauan
- Ask TD about longer top pieces and function/purpose/need?
- On bottom, note there is no frame drawn, ask TD what is needed/desired as this unit sits 2' above deck during show, not sitting on the deck
